CUT WOOD ON THE COMMON POLICY

- The piles of cut wood on the Common are there primarily to provide habitats for invertebrates.
- Cut wood on the Common is not available for collection by members of the public.
- We do allow members of our volunteer working parties to take away limited amounts of wood (in recognition of their efforts) but this is only with prior agreement of the Parish Council or the Working Party leadership.
- Unauthorised use of power tools on the Common is not permitted.
- Anyone given permission to collect wood needs to notify the Parish Council Clerk of when they expect to be on the Common, and the Clerk will advise members of the Common Management Committee and the Working Party leadership.
